

MARE CHECKLIST

This checklist has been provided to help you ensure that your mare is ready to travel to Stud – there is no need to send it to Kington Langley Stud.

BEFORE TRAVELLING TO STUD:

Have the following been posted / faxed to Kington Langley Stud in good time before sending your mare?

- CEM swab results – dated in current breeding season
- EVA blood test results – dated within 30 days of arrival at Stud
- Nomination Form – completed in full and signed
- Vet's Declaration – completed and signed by your vet

In addition, please check the following:

- Have you confirmed your mare's arrival date and approximate time with the Stud?
- If appropriate, has your insurance company been advised that you are sending your mare to Stud?
- If you have arranged to use frozen/chilled semen not available at Kington Langley Stud, have you made all arrangements concerning payment and delivery to Stud in time for insemination and advised the Stud accordingly?

TRAVELLING TO STUD:

Current DEFRA regulations now state that all horses must travel with their Passports and that the declaration concerning administration of medicinal treatments is signed by the owner:

- Passport ready to travel with the mare?
- Has the Declaration been signed in the Passport concerning administration of medicinal treatments (DEFRA regulations)?
